

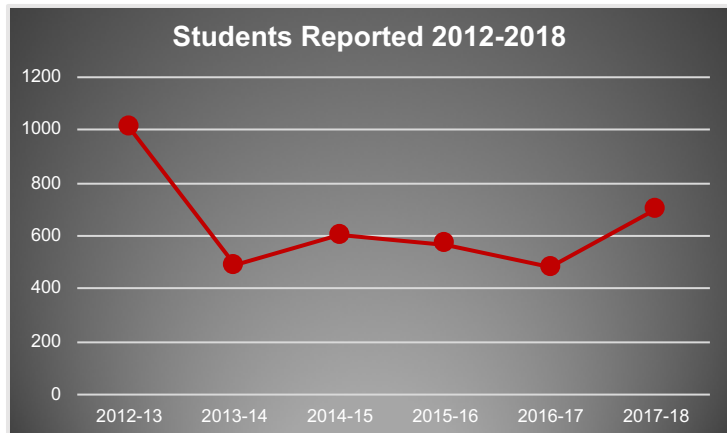


## Overview

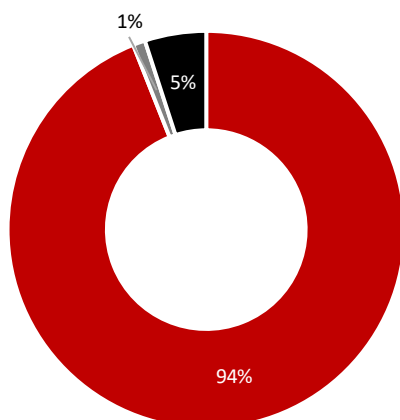
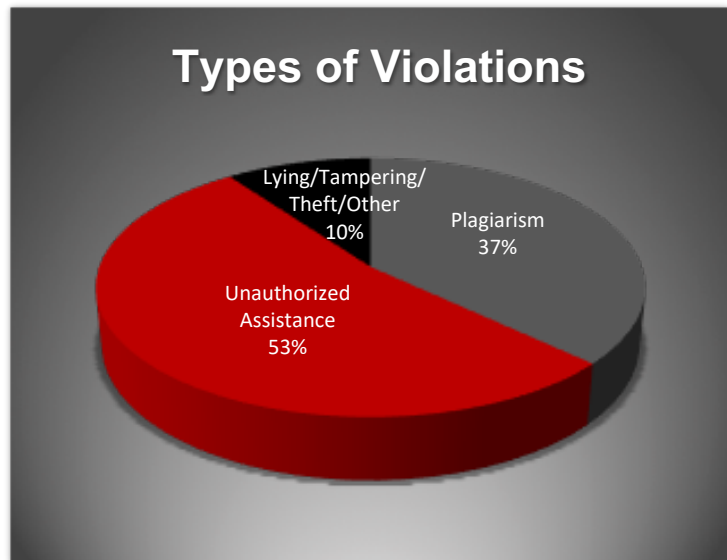
